Bring On 2021...Our Staff Are Ready!

When we began creating the vision for Emmaus House in 2013, there was one thing we knew for certain- **this program would be run by the Haitian people**. We worked to ensure that our Haitian staff were the ones creating and achieving their own objectives for the program, not just those we created for them. The Americans' job would be to ensure financial accountability and provide support to help the program grow. Starting with this end in mind has never paid off more than in the last 2 years. In 2019, Haiti was plaqued with political unrest, nearly shutting



down the entire country. Then in 2020, COVID hit all of us and further jeopardized Haiti's food security, economy, and safety. Our Haitian staff have been running Emmaus House with

the internet essentially being our only link for the last two years, and they have been killing it! As you will see in this report, despite these potentially devastating challenges, our youth have been moving forward and thriving. This is due to our tenacious, hard working, and determined staff working every day to keep the Emmaus family strong. Never have we been so grateful to have staff who are invested in our mission, able and willing to run operations, and who make wise

decisions to ensure the future security and sustainability of Emmaus House. With them, the future of Emmaus House in 2021 is so bright!
